Here at Greengate Lane Foundation Stage we aim to create a friendly, safe and supportive environment for all our children and staff.

In order to promote this environment we have high expectations of the standards of behaviour in our Foundation Stage. All children are aware of these expectations through our use of a common approach from all staff. Effective communication and continued support from parents and carers will help us to achieve this goal.

We want the children of Greengate Lane Foundation Stage to achieve their full potential, and we aim to achieve this by encouraging them to work well both as individuals and with others.

We will reward children with...

- Praise
- Reward stickers and stamps
- Good behaviour raffle tickets
- Headteacher praise / awards
- Whole school celebrations assembly
- School achievement board

We will address inappropriate behaviour by...

- Giving a verbal warning
- Time out on the 'thinking mat'
- Removal from situation / activity

Inappropriate behaviour will be recorded on a daily basis and this information passed to the Headteacher at the end of each week. Any persistent inappropriate behaviour will be discussed with parents / carers, alongside liaison with the Headteacher, learning mentor and SENCO.

More serious incidents will be dealt with immediately with support from senior management team, learning mentor and parents / carers, as appropriate.
