


Year 1 - Homework Menu

Week	Starter	Main	Dessert
1 21.2.22	<u>Maths</u> In the autumn term we learnt about shapes in Maths. To see what you can remember have a go at the shape quiz on Seesaw.	<u>History</u> Draw or paint a picture of Queen Elizabeth II. Write some facts about her.	<u>Literacy tree</u> Draw a picture of Beegu. Write about her using adjectives. For example, Beegu has two long yellow ears. 
2 28.2.22	<u>Phonics</u> Every day in phonics we read real and nonsense words. We spot the special friends, Fred talk and then read the word. Record yourself doing this on the Seesaw phonics activity.	<u>Art</u> We have been learning about style and pointillism. Can you create a piece of artwork of your choice in this style? You can use paint and cotton buds or felt tip pens.	<u>World Book Day</u> In preparation for world book day (3 rd March) write a book review about your favourite story. You could also draw a picture of your favourite book character.
3 7.3.22	<u>PE</u> On Seesaw I have added an activity called squat and shoot. Add some photos to your seesaw journal.	<u>Maths</u> On Seesaw I have added the place value to 50 quiz. Have a go and see how many you get right.	<u>History</u> Draw or paint a picture of King John I. Write some facts about him and/or the Magna Carta.
4 14.3.22	<u>Spelling</u> Look at the red words in your RWI storybook that we send home. Practise spelling them without looking. This can be completed on Seesaw on the glow spelling activity.	<u>Science</u> Create a poster or fact file about things we can do to help take care of our planet.	<u>Jigsaw</u> In our PSHE circle time (Jigsaw) our focus is 'Healthy Me.' Write about the things you do each day to keep healthy.
5 21.3.22	<u>Art</u> Look at different artwork by Vincent Van Gogh. Choose one that you like and write about why you like it.	<u>English</u> On Seesaw complete the singular and plural activity. You could also write your own list of singular and plural words.	<u>Maths</u> On Seesaw I have added the length and height quiz. Have a go and see how many you get right. There is also a link to an online game we've played in school.
6 28.3.22	<u>Easter</u> I would love to see your Easter crafts this week. You can bring them to school or share photos on Seesaw.	<u>RE</u> Why do Christians celebrate Easter? You can write and/or draw your response to this question.	<u>PE</u> On Seesaw I have added an activity called spell it out. Add some photos to your seesaw journal.
