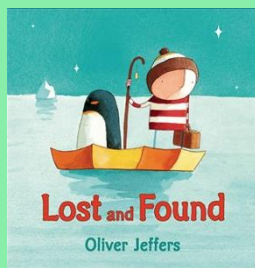


Read, Write, Inc.

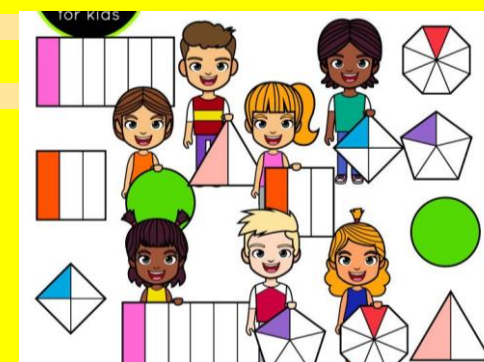
Maths

Number: Multiplication and Division

In this block we will build on our knowledge of counting in multiples of two, five and ten. We will make equal groups and add them. We will learn how to make arrays and also look at groups and sharing.

Number: Fractions

In this block we will learn about halves and quarters in both objects and amounts.

Geography

In music we will be learning songs about “Story Time” and “Our bodies.”

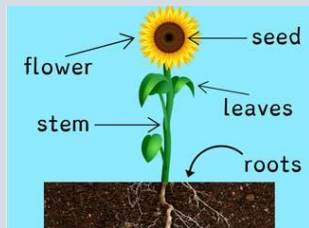


ICT

Physical Education

Reading at home

Book bags need to be brought to school every day and books will be collected on Tuesday. Please listen to your child read every day as this is the best way to improve their fluency. Record the date each time you listen to them read in their reading record. Rewards will be given to the children that are reading at home each week. **REMEMBER IT ONLY NEEDS TO BE FIVE OR TEN MINUTES.**

What books will my child bring home?

Your child will receive one book bag book each week that will be from the same colour scheme that they are reading each day in Read, Write Inc. lessons. Then they will also bring home a copy of the book they’ve read during Read, Write, Inc. This will be either every three days or five days depending on the colour band. Record all reading in your child’s reading record.
