Week	Starter	Main	Dessert

Literacy tree Draw a picture of Yeti from "Yeti and the bird" by Nadia Shireen. Write adjectives to describe what the character looks like.	Maths Draw a simple grid and create your one treasure map. Write simple instructions to guide someone. For example, forwards one, turn left etc.
3 20.6.22	Maths Play the bead numbers activity online to support our place value learning. Link on Seesaw.	History Draw a picture of the Houses of Parliament and write a sentence about it.	Art In school we have used clay to make a model of a penguin. At home draw, paint or collage a picture of a penguin.
4 27.6.22	Art This week we visited Yorkshire Sculpture Park. Write about what you enjoyed most about the day.	Science/DT Design an umbrella or a raincoat for someone to wear to help them stay dry in the rain.	Maths Play the online money game. Link on Seesaw.
5 4.7.22	History Find out about the job of the Prime Minister. Write down some questions that you would ask Mr Johnson.	English Play Karate Cats on BBC bitesize and practise spelling, punctuation and grammar. Link on Seesaw.	Jigsaw – Changing me Draw a picture of yourself as a baby and one of you today. Write about the things you can do now that you couldn't when you were a baby.
6 11.7.22	Religious Education Draw a picture of your family. Write about how your family care for you and how you care for them.	Maths Play the telling the time game and practise time to the hour and the half hour. Link on Seesaw.	Science Chocolate experiment. What happens to chocolate when it gets warm? What happens when it gets cold? Record your findings or take photographs.
