<b>1</b> 17.4.23	<b>Maths</b> On Seesaw I have added the link to the online robot addition game.	<b>Geography</b> Recall the seven continents. Research which continent is the smallest and which is the largest? Write down some facts and/or draw some pictures.	<b>Phonics screening practise</b> Complete the real and nonsense word sheets. The children need to spot the special friends, Fred talk and read the word.
<b>2</b> 24.4.23	<b>.PE</b> On Seesaw view the activity 'cross the swap.' Take a photo of your child taking part to add to their Seesaw journal.	<b>Science</b> Draw a detailed picture of a plant and include the roots. Label the different parts of the plant and write a sentence about what plants need to grow.	<b>Maths</b> Practise writing your numbers up to fifty. You can write them in numbers, words or both. You could create your own fifty grid.
<b>3</b> 1.5.23	<b>Phonics screening practise</b> Complete the real and nonsense word sheets. The children need to spot the special friends, Fred talk and read the word.	<b>Art</b> We have been looking at the painting 'The Graham Children' by William Hogarth. Choose a child to sketch using a pencil.	<b>King Charles III</b> Design your own flag to celebrate the coronation of King Charles III.
<b>4</b> 8.5.23	<b>Maths</b> Continue to practise addition and subtraction within 20. Draw your own tens frames or part whole models to represent your calculations.	<b>Geography</b> Create a poster to tell people about the continent Antarctica.	<b>Phonics screening practise</b> Complete the real and nonsense word sheets. The children need to spot the special friends, Fred talk and read the word.
<b>5</b> 15.5.23	<b>.PE</b> On Seesaw view the activity 'magic carpet.' Take a photo of your child taking part to add to their Seesaw journal.	<b>Science</b> We have been learning about evergreen and deciduous trees. Draw a deciduous tree during each season. Write a sentence to compare the different types of trees.	<b>Art</b> We have been looking at 'Children's games' by Pieter Bruegel. Draw or paint a picture of children today playing a game or with a modern toy.
<b>6</b> 22.5.23	<b>Phonics screening practise</b> Complete the real and nonsense word sheets. The children need to spot the special friends, Fred talk and read the word.	<b>Geography</b> Seesaw activity – label the seven continents.	<b>Handwriting</b> On Seesaw I have added some handwriting practise sheets.
