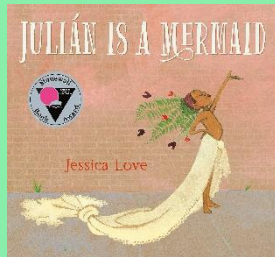


## Read, Write, Inc.

## Geography

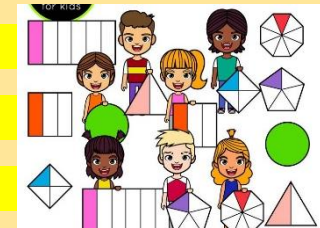
Following on from our previous topic about the United Kingdom, this half term we will be learning about continents.



## Maths

### Fractions

In this unit we will identify  $\frac{1}{2}$  and  $\frac{1}{4}$  of a shape, object and quantity.



### Measures: length and mass

We will compare and measure length and mass using cm and kg. In addition to this we will also look at doubling and halving.

### Numbers 50 to 100 and beyond

We will read, write, represent, compare and order numbers to 100. We will look at one more/fewer and 10 more/fewer. We will also look at number patterns.

## Religious Education

We will be looking at Judaism and our question is "Is Shabbat important to Jewish children?"



## Music

Our music will be based on the song "Your Imagination." We will be clapping rhythms and looking at instruments.

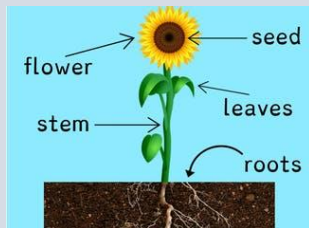


## ICT

## Physical Education

## Reading at home

Book bags need to be brought to school every day and books will be collected on Monday. Please listen to your child read every day as this is the best way to improve their fluency. Record the date each time you listen to them read in their reading record. Rewards will be given to the children that are reading at home each week. **REMEMBER IT ONLY NEEDS TO BE FIVE OR TEN MINUTES.**

**What books will my child bring home?**

Your child will receive one book bag each week that will be from the same colour scheme that they are reading each day in Read, Write Inc. lessons. Then they will also bring home a copy of the book they've read during Read, Write, Inc. This will be either every three days or five days depending on the colour band. Record all reading in your child's reading record.
