<b>1</b> 4.9.23	<p><b><u>Geography</u></b></p> <p>We have been learning that an aerial photo means something from above. Choose an object in your house and draw what it looks like from above, ask family members to guess what it is.</p>	<p><b><u>Science</u></b></p> <p>Draw a part of your body and label the parts you can name.</p> 	<p><b><u>Maths</u></b></p> <p>On Seesaw play the Yeti counting game or teddy bear counting game. Both have been added to Seesaw.</p> 
<b>2</b> 11.9.23	<p><b><u>Art</u></b></p> <p>Use primary colours to create a piece of art in the style of Piet Mondrian. You can use paint, pens or pencils or even complete it on Seesaw.</p> 	<p><b><u>PSHE</u></b></p> <p>Make a poster about things you can do to keep safe or people you can ask for help.</p>	<p><b><u>Maths</u></b></p> <p>Choose a number from one to ten. Can you say what number is one more and one less? Record the number as a numeral or a word and draw a representation.</p>
<b>3</b> 18.9.23	<p><b><u>Maths</u></b></p> <p>Practise counting in 1s. Can you start from a different number and carry on the sequence? Can you count backwards in 1s.</p>	<p><b><u>PE</u></b></p> <p>Create your own obstacle course either indoors or outdoors. Take a photo to add to your Seesaw journal.</p>	<p><b><u>Geography</u></b></p> <p>Draw a simple map to show how you get to school, the park or the shop. Add labels for buildings and other landmarks.</p>
<b>4</b> 25.9.23	<p><b><u>Science</u></b></p> <p>Write about the five senses and draw some pictures. You could use the sentence starters – I can see... I can hear... I can taste... I can touch... I can smell...</p>	<p><b><u>Art</u></b></p> <p>Create a piece of artwork based on Van Gogh's Sunflowers.</p> 	<p><b><u>Maths</u></b></p> <p>Practise counting in multiples of ten up to 100. Can you record the numbers?</p>
<b>5</b> 2.10.23	<p><b><u>PSHE</u></b></p> <p>We have been learning about road safety. Draw a picture and/or write a sentence to explain how to cross the road safely.</p>	<p><b><u>PE</u></b></p> <p>Complete some challenges in 30 seconds and record how many you can do. For example, star jump, laps of the garden etc.</p>	<p><b><u>Maths</u></b></p> <p>Have a go at the caterpillar ordering game on Seesaw.</p> 
<b>6</b> 9.10.23	<p><b><u>Maths</u></b></p> <p>Practise counting in tens. On seesaw play the counting in tens game.</p> 	<p><b><u>Science</u></b></p> <p>Are you brave enough to use your sense of taste and try a blindfolded taste test! Can you guess the food? Take some photos to add to your Seesaw journal.</p>	<p><b><u>Art</u></b></p> <p>We have looked at Monet's Shadows by the Sea. Create a piece of artwork linked to the sea.</p>
<b>7</b> 16.10.23	<p>Choose your favourite book. Draw a picture from it and write what you like about it.</p>	<p><b><u>Maths</u></b></p> <p>Go on a 3D shape hunt. Use the activity to Seesaw to record what you've found.</p>	<p><b><u>Science</u></b></p> <p>Go on a walk and spot signs of Autumn. Take some photos to add to your Seesaw journal.</p>
